AS 1000 - Consortium

3-18 Credits (Repeatable for credit)

AS 1200 - Introduction to Scientific Problem Solving

1 Credit

Introduction to Scientific Problem Solving prepares incoming students for success in introductory STEM classes. This course is designed to facilitate the transition to university by introducing students to academic resources, building critical-thinking skills, and improving the quantitative literacy skills necessary for first-year STEM coursework.

AS 1500 - Introduction to Undergraduate Research

1 Credit

This multidisciplinary course offers an introduction to undergraduate research in the College of Arts and Sciences at SLU. It is designed to develop students' skills, knowledge, and identities as researchers. The semester-long program introduces important issues in research, preparing students for mentored undergraduate research as well as academic and professional endeavors in their chosen fields.

AS 1840 - Career Decision Making

1 Credit

Assists students who are deciding on a major or career. This course is designed to help students gain an understanding of self and world of work and to become familiar with career-related resources. This course does not fulfill Social Science requirement.

AS 3500 - Casa Belize Praxis Seminar

3 Credits

Based on academic background, personal interests, and professional goals, students are assigned a praxis site in a local Belizean marginal community. Students learn from the people in that community two full days per week for the entire semester. This learning environment cultivates an awareness of and sensitivity to the realities of those who are struggling to end social injustices while working to promote human dignity. The Belizeans in the praxis sites are co-professors of this class. Students enter the praxis sites as learners, not as volunteers, and immerse themselves in the "classroom" of the marginalized of Belize.
